How much Maloff Protect does the customer need?

Maloff Protect will need to be taken **once daily** to ensure the maximum chemoprophylactic benefits.

Customers should purchase enough tablets to cover the following:

- One or two days before travelling to an area which has malaria
- AND the total number of days they expect to be in the malaria area
- AND the seven days after returning to a malaria-free area

7 (1 week)	16	1 x 24
14 (2 weeks)	23	1 x 24
21 (3 weeks)	30	1 x 36
28 (4 weeks)	37	2 x 24
42 (6 weeks)	51	1 x 36, 1 x 24
56 (8 weeks)	65	2 x 36
84 (12 weeks)	93	2 x 36, 1 x 24

The maximum duration of travel for which Maloff Protect can be supplied without prescription is 12 weeks (93 tablets). For longer durations of travel, advice should be sought from a doctor or other qualified prescriber.
