IMPORTANT: Peel this label at corner and read BEFORE use. Do not tear off, re-fix for future use.

Symptomatic relief of mild sunburn and minor skin conditions.
Apply to the skin.
SHAKE THE BOTTLE.
Adults, the elderly and children: Apply with a pad of cotton wool to the affected skin as required.

FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY.
Peel where shown for further precautions.
Active ingredients: calamine 15% w/v, zinc oxide 5% w/v.
Also contains: bentonite (E558), sodium citrate, glycerol (E422), phenol and purified water.

Calamine Lotion is a mild astringent and antiseptic. It relieves the symptoms of mild sunburn and minor skin conditions.

1. Before you use this medicine
⚠ Do not use the medicine if you have....

- An **allergy** to any of the ingredients listed on the front.
- Ask your doctor before use if having an x-ray, as the product may mask the x-ray picture.

⚠ Pregnant or breastfeeding....
Using Calamine Lotion during pregnancy and breastfeeding is unlikely to have any ill effects when used as directed. If unsure, talk to your doctor or pharmacist.

2. Possible side effects
Like all medicines, this medicine can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

If you get these side effects stop using the lotion and see a doctor:

- Allergic/irritant reaction (e.g. skin rash, red or itchy skin).

If you notice any side effects, stop use and tell your doctor or pharmacist. They will tell you what to do.

Reporting of side effects
If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. You can also report side effects directly via the Yellow Card Scheme at: www.mhra.gov.uk/yellowcard

3. Further information
